N.R.A. Firearms Safety Training

Thank you for your interest in firearm safety instruction. Firearm safety is an important subject whether or not you own, plan to own, or have a firearm in your house.

In reading this, you are either planning to apply for a concealed carry permit, or want to know how to safely handle, operate, or possess a firearm.

Taking the ***GunSafe Firearms Safety Training Course*** is a very important first step to owning a firearm. Statistics show that four out of every ten adults live in homes which have a firearm and the average home has two guns in it. Statistics also show that most firearm accidents happen at home when unauthorized persons handle a firearm, a child's curiosity causes a dangerous situation, or someone does not know how to safely handle, shoot, clean, or store a firearm. Since the **National Rifle Association** has implemented a firearms safety training Course, the firearm accidents have decreased almost 70 percent while gun ownership has doubled and the population has quadrupled.
